

How to find the Chocolate Factory..form Gower.

1. South Gower (Oxwich, Port Eynon, Bishopston Reynoldston etc)

Take the A4118, commonly known as the South Gower road towards Swansea.

You will eventually pass Swansea airport on your LHS.

After Swansea airport, you will pass through Upper Killay and will then drop down a steep valley.

You will pass the Railway Inn on RHS at the bottom of the valley, before climbing up the other side.

Proceed along this road to a mini roundabout and take the third exit towards Swansea. There is a large Chapel on this mini roundabout.

You will now be passing through Killay, there will be a parade of shops on your LHS. This road is still the A4118, know as Gower Road.

Proceed along this road. You will pass a Murco s/stn on your LHS and after a mini roundabout you will pass Olchfa Comprehensive school on your RHS. Carry onto Swansea.

Eventually, you will drop down another steepish hill, with a set of traffic lights at the bottom.

You are now in Sketty. At the traffic lights you will turn left onto Vivian Road, passing the Vivian Arms on your LHS and The Bush on your RHS.

You will go up a fairly steep hill, over a mini roundabout and at the top of the hill there will be a double mini roundabout.

At these mini roundabouts, turn left following signs to Carmarthen M4. You are still on the A4216 (Cockett Road)

Follow this road , you will pass a Shell Garage on your RHS before going down a steep hill. At the bottom of this hill you will go straight through a set of traffic lights and up another hill.

At the top of this hill you will pass St.Peters Church (Church of Wales) on your RHS. Going down the hill on the other side you will need to get into the RH lane to go through the next set of lights.

Proceed along what is now Station Road, which after a few hundred yards splits into three lanes, you should get into the LH lane to turn left at the next set of lights.

At these Traffic lights you will see The Marquis Arms on your LHS.

Turn left onto the A483 (Carmarthen Road) and stay in the LH lane.

A the next set of traffic lights there is an American Golf shop and a Majestic wine merchant on your LHS, there is the Star pub on the RHS and on the other side of the lights, a Texaco garage. There is also a sign, 'Swansea West Industrial Park'

Turn left at these lights and you are now on the Kingsway!

The road bends to the right and you will pass Hurns/Tomas Watkins depot on your LHS. Follow the road over the brow of the hill and we are on the LHS.

2. From North Gower. (Llangennith , Llanmadoc, Penclawdd, Crofty, Llanrhidian)

Take the B4295 (at Llanrhidian) to Gowerton. Before arriving at Gowerton you will pass through Penclawdd and just before arriving in Gowerton you will pass a Tesco petrol garage on your RHS.

At the end of this road you will come to a set of traffic lights.

At these lights turn right onto Victoria Road, the B 4296. You will pass under a low railway bridge and a Rugby club on your LHS.

Proceed along this road and you will pass a small golf course on your LHS.

At the next mini roundabout take the third exit , the A484 towards Swansea. You will go up a gradual incline, proceeding along a straight stretch of road with three lanes , two up , one down.

At the top you will come to a mini roundabout, at which you will take the 2nd exit.

At the next roundabout you will come to dual carriageway, you will need to take the 2nd exit on to the A483 towards Swansea.

You will pass by a large Tesco Extra on your RHS.

At the third set of traffic lights, turn right. There is a RH filter lane at this set of lights and a Texaco garage on your RHS.

You are now in Swansea West Industrial Park and on the Kingsway.

We are 500 yards on the Kingsway on the LHS.
